

## **Supervised Agricultural Experience Program** **Record Book Requirements in AFNR**

Every student enrolled in Agricultural Education courses is required to complete an SAEP record book. With the help of parents, guardians, relatives, employers, and teachers they may complete Suggested Activities for credit hours to fulfill the requirements. Each course has a specific set of Suggested Activities from which students may select to complete during the semester. They may complete more activities to increase that portion of their grade.

***They may take home the list of Suggested Activities, but must leave the actual SAE record book in the Agriculture Building classroom. Entries must be written in PENCIL only.***

SAE books are graded at the end of the Six Weeks. The grade made by the student is used as three (3) Test grades and three (3) Daily grades. Each Suggested Activity earns one (1) credit hour, Unrelated to Class (URC) activities earn one (1) credit hour each (maximum of 6 URC per Six Weeks), twenty-five (25) hours are earned each Six Weeks for being enrolled in the class, there is no limit on earning FFA credit hours if you are an FFA member. FFA hours include practice for any LDE/CDE team for 20 hours then 4 hours for each contest. Showing projects earns 4 hours per show with a maximum of 5 shows per year. A student may choose to have an SAE(animal/crop/shop) project related to the Agriscience in which they are enrolled to earn 20 credit hours per semester.
