1. Student must have an IEP or a signed Notice of Intent to Graduate Under the Minimum Plan on file to graduate under this plan.
2. Student must satisfy one of the three criteria in order to opt into the MHSP: Be at least 16 years of age; Have completed 2 credits required for graduation in each subject of the foundation of the curriculum; or have failed to be promoted to grade 10 one or more times.
3. If ARD committee places a student on a modified curriculum in a subject area, the student will automatically be placed on the MHSP
4. **Credit may not be earned for any TEKS-based course more than once.**
